SAFEGUARDING SUNDAY

"Sunday, February 22, is Diocesan Safeguarding Sunday. It is the First Sunday of Lent and appropriately so, as we enter the Penitential Season and seek forgiveness for past failings. In his address at the January Consistory Pope Leo XIV reminded all that "abuse itself causes a deep wound, which may last a lifetime; but often the scandal in the Church is that the door was closed and victims were not welcomed or accompanied with the closeness of authentic pastors....."

"Safeguarding Sunday is once again an opportunity to acknowledge and recognise the years of dedication and work by so many to ensure that Kildare and Leighlin Diocese is a safe place for children and all who work with them. It's an opportunity to thank all who today ensure safeguarding is so well embedded in our diocesan culture, Ailish Higgins, our Director of Safeguarding, currently on maternity leave, Michele Hughes, our Acting Designated Liaison Person, the Diocesan Safeguarding Representatives, our priests, our deacons and our people, particularly the many who volunteer at parish level, ensuring the life and vitality of their faith community....."
