### The Canaanite Woman

When in the Old Testament the walls of Jericho came tumbling down, it marked the conquest of Canaan by the Jews and since that time the Canaanites and Jews were enemies. Today's Gospel tells us about a very brave Canaanite woman who approaches Jesus seeking a cure for her sick daughter.

This woman was not welcomed by the disciples of Jesus. They just wanted her to go away-"Give her what she wants". Then surprisingly, Jesus too is a bit harsh. He does not help her. Instead Jesus says "I was sent to the lost sheep of Israel" not to the Canaanites who he compares to "house dogs". This is how a Jew would usually treat an enemy, but from Jesus this is unexpected behaviour.

The story does not end there. This strong woman has faith that Jesus can help her, hope that Jesus will change his mind, and a great love for her daughter. She kneels at the feet of Jesus and says "Lord help me". Jesus recognises her Faith, her Hope and her Love. The more familiar merciful Jesus that we know, grants the Canaanite woman her wish. Her daughter is cured.

Jesus shows us in this Gospel that His message is not only for us. Others too can reach Him through Faith, Hope and Love.
