Twenty First Sunday in Ordinary Time.

There are people who say the Coronavirus pandemic is Divine revenge for our denial of God. Our Gospel today deals with the fate of the best known person to deny Jesus-Simon Peter.

Saint Peter was always a special apostle. He witnessed the raising of the daughter of Jairus from the dead and he was present at the Transfiguration when Moses and Elijah appeared with Jesus. But Peter was also an unpredictable man. He cut off a man's ear with a sword trying to defend Jesus when he was being arrested. Shortly afterwards Peter denied he even knew who Jesus was.

But Jesus knew who Peter was. He even predicted Peter's denial of him. Despite knowing of his denial. Jesus says something extraordinary to Peter in our Gospel today. "I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of God." Jesus then goes even further, telling Peter of the important role Peter will play in the future. "You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church".

Jesus did not disown Peter for his denial of God. There was no revenge.

Let us pray that we can endure these difficult times we are going through. These days too will pass. But one thing will remain. God wants the best for us. God wants to be in our lives and God is not disowning or denying us.
