The Holy Trinity – Trinty Sunday.

There's a story about a young man who climbs a mountain to meet a famous guru. He wakes the guru from his sleep and the guru says, "What can I do for you, young man?" The young man says, "I want you to explain God to me." The guru smiles and says, "A God that can be explained is not a God that you should worship." The guru went back to sleep.

We have little understanding of the Holy Trinity –three persons in the One God – but we learned during the Easter Season how they are joined together to carry out their plan for the salvation of each one of us.

God the Father sent his Son Jesus Christ in to the world to explain how every person can have a relationship with God. Jesus Christ died and then rose from the dead promising that we can have eternal life with him if we follow his commands and are good Christians.
