You've got to have Faith.

We all struggle to cope with two great fears-death and suffering. In our World we can control almost everything, but we can only delay death and we have incomplete control over illness.

Our Gospel today is about these two great fears. Jairus fears his daughter will die and an unnamed woman is worried her long term illness will ruin her life. So they both seek out Jesus. They brave large crowds to get near to him. Jesus responds to them.

The daughter of Jairus is raised from the dead and the woman's illness is cured. We are unlikely to experience such extraordinary miracles in our lives, so what is the message of the Gospel? Jesus tells us we must have Faith. "Do not be afraid, only have Faith," he said to Jairus. "Your faith has restored you to health" he tells the woman.

Explaining this Gospel in 2018, Pope Francis said that the raising of the daughter of Jairus reminds us of the power of Jesus Christ, who has promised eternal life to those who believe in him. "Jesus is the wellspring of lifethe one who restores life to those who trust fully in him".

The ill woman's "faith attracts the divine saving power that is in Christ, who, feeling that "power had gone forth from him" tried to understand who it was." Those who seek out Jesus, and have Faith in Him, can draw him in to their lives.

We pray today for Faith when our greatest fears surround us.
