Laws and Rules

All our lives are governed by laws and unwritten rules. Our workplace, our school rooms, our shops, our roads, the sports we play-all operate under written laws and unwritten rules-traditions which have developed over the years. Our readings today are around this theme of laws and rules.

In the first reading Moses asks the Jews to "keep the commandments of the Lord your God". If they do so he promises his people "they will have life". Saint James, in the second reading, asks that we "accept and submit to the word that has been planted in you. The word refers to the life Jesus wishes us to live and the rules he asks us to live by. Saint James promises us that these rules can "save your souls"

Jesus in our Gospel criticizes the Scribes and the Pharisees for too immersed in the details of Jewish Law. The Ten Commandments of Moses has become over 600 laws in the Jewish Talmud. Jesus says "you put aside the commandment of God to cling to human traditions". The spirit of the law had become bogged down in the traditions that developed around the law. For example Jesus says that telling people what they should, and should not eat is a waste of time". Salvation does not come through the rules in life you follow. It comes from the path in life you follow.

Those who will be saved are described in the Psalm -Those who walk without fault, act without justice, speak the truth from the heart, don't slander, do no wrong to his brother.

Let us pray today for the wisdom to understand the meaning of these words and the courage to live them.
