*Our Gospel today sets out the attitude of Jesus towards those who ignore him. Our second reading talks about the danger of self indulgence, which arises if we fail to receive Jesus into our lives.*

#### **Samaritan town**

*When Jesus goes into a town in Samaria "the people would not receive him". The disciples were very annoyed at this snub. "Lord, do you want us to call down fire from heaven to burn them up?". Jesus turned and rebuked them, and they went off to another village. In Ireland, Jesus enters every town each Sunday through the Eucharist-but the people would not receive him. Active Catholics are annoyed by this snub and wonder why the Lord does not call down fire from heaven to burn them up?. In reality, those who would not receive Jesus, suffer no consequences as a result of their rejection of Jesus. Jesus is forgiving and patient. He constantly calls us to receive him.*

*When we don't receive Jesus into our lives there is a danger we can become self indulgent.*

#### **Self Indulgence**

*We live in a self indulgent world. Some call it an "Ego Drama" where we hear people say "I am starring in a wonderful drama which I have written, directed and produced. Life is all about me." Our second reading tells us that if we receive Jesus we will be guided by the Holy Spirit not our ego. "If you are guided by the Spirit you will be in no danger of yielding to self-indulgence, since self-indulgence is the opposite of the Spirit".*

#### **Our Prayer**

*Lord grant us the wisdom we need to receive you into our lives. Lord help us to recognise when we are being self indulgent and moving away from you.*
