Our readings today are about the importance of detaching ourselves  
from the search for Money, Power, Success, Fame, Pleasure, Notoriety, Celebrity,  
Popularity-all aspects to life, we as a society value highly.

These objectives are, in themselves good but they are fickle and soon  
evaporate. We seem to realise their fickle nature. As they inevitably slip away

never ending effort to retain or replace our worldly goals. They become our life

The first reading comments on the futility of this activity. “What does

be on heavenly things, not on the things that are on the earth.” The Gospel gives  
further advice “kill everything in you that belongs only to earthly life.”

Mother Teresa has some thoughts; God won't ask us for the number  
of degrees we had, the balance of our bank accounts, or the highest position we  
attained in our careers. (He will ask us) How did we live without the love that  
we've been blessed with?

We have opportunities every day to serve others (especially in our  
families)-opportunities that may never arise again. Think of the times that some-  
one extended a loving hand when you needed it. Perhaps they had no idea that  
you needed it! You can be that person to others...you need to be that person to  
others.

Lord, grant us the wisdom to choose wise priorities in life.
