Peace

Because of the terrible war in Ukraine, we are very conscious of the absence of peace in our world. We long for an end to that war. When peace is absent - within countries or within individuals - conflict, sadness and suffering seem to fill the void.

Our Gospel

Our readings today have Peace at their core. These are Jesus' instructions to the first disciples sent out to Proclaim the Good News. 'Whatever house you go into, let your first words be, "Peace to this house!" And if a man of peace lives there, your peace will go and rest on him; if not, it will come back to you.

Peace at the heart of the Gospels.

Peace is mentioned almost four Hundred times in the Bible. But it is the special place of Peace in the New Testament which is most significant. When Jesus appeared to his disciples after his resurrection, He greeted them with the words "Peace be with you". Jesus' primary wish for us is that we be at Peace. Jesus warns us that I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. Christians will always be challenged but we can still be at peace.

Personal Prayer and Peace

When we pray for others, we can never know if our prayers are fully answered. Yet people of prayer continue to pray fervently, and those around them continue to ask for their prayers. Prayer brings peace to those who pray. Prayer brings peace to those who are prayed for. Only through Jesus and prayer can we find real peace.

Restless heart

Saint Augustine wrote about God being the only source of Peace :-

O Lord you have made me for yourself and my heart is restless until it finds its rest in you. This morning please notice how many times the word Peace is mentioned in our Mass. Let us pray sincerely for peace in our world, in our country, in our homes and in our hearts.
