Brother Camillus Regan – Platinum Jubilee.

In August 1952, Brother Camillus Regan began his Novitiate with the Patrician Brothers in Mount Saint Joseph - now Mount Wolesey- Tullow. After his teacher training, Brother Camillus worked as a teacher in Galway and Carrickmacross, and then as a school Principal in Mountrath and Tullow.

The education system in Ireland has developed hugely in those seven decades. In 1952 there were 300,000 children attending Primary School up to the age 14. However only 4% of these children would continue on to complete Secondary education. Today there are 550,000 students in Primary schools, the vast majority of whom will move on to Secondary education and indeed to Third level.

All the Irish Religious congregations fulfilled a need in the education area over the last two hundred and fifty years. The Patrician Brothers continue to work as educators, with houses in India, Australia, United States, Papua New Guinea and Africa. Brother Camillus continues to contribute to education in Kildare and Leighlin Diocese as Secretary of the Diocesan Education Council.

Brother Camillus has always been very supportive of parish activities in the communities where he has lived. Bishop Denis Nulty presented him with a Benemerenti Medal from Pope Francis on February 25th 2017 in recognition of his services to Tullow Parish. In 2022, Brother Camillus was the recipient of the Sister Eileen Randles Award *“in recognition of the sterling work he has done on behalf of education in Kildare and Leighlin Diocese and on this island.”*

On the occasion of his 70th Anniversary – Platinum Jubilee - it is appropriate to express our thanks and appreciation to Brother Camillus Regan for his services to education and to our Parish Community.

Congratulations and thank you Brother Camillus.
