## Pride makes us artificial, Humility makes us real (Thomas Merton)

Our readings today are on the subject of Humility. First reading-Behave humbly, and you will find favour with the Lord. Gospel-'the man who humbles himself will be exalted'. Many of the aspects of humility, which help us to live good Christian lives, also help us to lead positive "everyday" lives too.

### 1. Being a good listener.

Listening to God and trying to be guided in our lives by the words and teachings of His son Jesus is a sign of humility. Sunday Mass is where the words inspired by God are heard each week. Society values those who have a genuine interest in others and who are prepared to listen carefully to people's concerns. A good listener enriches the lives of those around them.

### 2. Say "Thank You"

Humility is taking the time to be appreciative of the many blessings God has showed upon us. Health, relative prosperity, peace of mind, our families and loved ones. Being appreciative of those who support us every day-from retail and hospitality staff to our colleagues and family members who support us, is humility.

### 3. Taking Responsibility.

The first words uttered by Jesus when he started his ministry were "Repent for the Kingdom of God is at hand." We find it hard to acknowledge that we are sinners. The reality is the vast majority of people want to "do the right thing" however our sins arise mostly from what we fail to do. Accepting our failings is humility. Society often admires individuals who accept their mistakes and who don't blame "the system" or others for their errors. It requires strength to take responsibility.

### 4. Asking For Help.

Turning to God and putting our lives in his care through prayer is a vital part of Humility. Saying The Lord's Prayer is the perfect way to commence a journey towards humility. None of us knows all the answers. Acknowledging this can be difficult. Seeking help is a sign of humility but also an important way to keep well.

### 5. Not being critical or judgemental about people and forgiving.

Forgiveness is humility. We acknowledge that others have weaknesses as do we. Rejoicing in the successes of those around us is Humility and can foster a very positive home or work environment.
