### **33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time**

As we come towards the end of the Liturgical year, our Gospel addresses the uncertainty around the end of the world.

#### **The end?**

Jesus describes a time when “Nation will fight against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be great earthquakes and plagues and famines here and there; there will be fearful sights and great signs from heaven.”

#### **Turbulent times**

Our world is experiencing very disturbing times. There is war in Ukraine. There are migrant crises in Europe and the United States. A looming Climate calamity threatens our existence. These issues are driven by bad human behaviour. A change in that behaviour could improve and probably could end these problems. What would that change in behaviour look like?

#### **The Christian response.**

The Christian message is “love of God and love of neighbour” or as Fr. Peter McVerry says “live simply and give generously”. If people lived more simply, and were prepared to give more generously our current difficult problems could be transformed.

Jesus asks us to start the process when He says in the Gospel that difficult times are our “opportunity to bear witness.” - our opportunity to live simply and give generously as Jesus did.

#### **Other Faiths**

These Christian values are common to most mainstream religions. Let us pray for a rebirth in religious values of loving God and Neighbour - Living simply and giving generously. Let us pray that we bear witness to this message in our own lives. Jesus says it will not be easy. “You will be hated by all men on account of my name, but not a hair of your head will be lost.” Jesus is always with us.
