# Corpus Christi

Today is Corpus Christi or the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. On this day we Catholics celebrate the Real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist in a real and substantive way and not just symbolically.

The official description of the doctrine behind this celebration was clarified by the Council of Trent in the 1500s. "... by the consecration of the bread and wine there takes place a change of the whole substance of the bread into the substance of the body of Christ our Lord and of the whole substance of the wine into the substance of his blood. This change the holy Catholic Church has fittingly and properly called transubstantiation."

#### Our readings

The second reading from Saint Paul today is seen as central to the transubstantiation doctrine. The blessing-cup that we bless is a communion with the blood of Christ, and the bread that we break is a communion with the body of Christ.

In our Gospel today Jesus emphasises that partaking in the Eucharist is vital for our salvation 'I am the living bread which has come down from heaven. Anyone who eats this bread will live for ever; and the bread that I shall give is my flesh, for the life of the world.'

While it is possible to understand the concept of bread and wine becoming the Body and blood of Christ, the teaching itself and how it works, is a mystery to us.

#### Finally

The final words of Jesus in Saint Matthew's gospel are "And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." Christ's spirit is given to us in Baptism and He is with us in the gift of the Eucharist.
