#### Sunday 25 June 2023 - 12th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Our readings today deal with opposition to God and Christianity. In our First reading, the prophet Jeremiah tells us he is being terrorised and denounced "from every side." In our Gospel Jesus asks us to declare ourselves for him "in the presence of men" and to not be afraid to do so.

#### **Opposition**

We should not be surprised by opposition to the beliefs, practices and traditions we embrace as Christians. According to Open Doors, 13 Christians worldwide are killed every day because of their faith. Every day, 12 churches or Christian buildings are attacked. Over 300 million Christian people live in countries where they are routinely persecuted for following Jesus.

#### A resilient Church

In 1784 a young Korean man was baptised in China taking the name Peter. He returned to Korea taking with him religious writings. When a Chinese missionary arrived in Korea in 1795 he found a vibrant and growing Christian Church which had no priests. It was not until 1845 that the first Korean Catholic priest was ordained.

The Church survives because at its core is God. The Church does not seek power or wealth which are usually the motivation for large scale human activity. The Church is guided by Jesus who said "Behold, I am with you always." He assures us that "the gates of hell will not prevail against" his Church.

#### <u>Prayer</u>

The Prophet Jeremiah in our reading assures us of the support of God. "But the Lord is at my side, a mighty hero". Let us pray for belief in our Mighty God who will not abandon us.
