The Transfiguration

9.30 a.m.

Nearing the end

At The Transfiguration, which comes towards the end of the formal mission of Jesus, the voice of God is heard saying 'This is my Son, the Beloved; he enjoys my favour :- Listen to Him. Similar words were heard at the start of the Mission of Jesus during the Baptism of Jesus, However there is one striking difference in the use of the words at the Transfiguration. At the Baptism, they were addressed to Jesus. At the Transfiguration they are directed towards the Apostles. God is handing over the work of Jesus to the Apostles and they have handed on this work to us. The writer Rebecca Hamilton explains why the apostles joined Jesus.

Peter, James and John didn't know why they were walking to the top of this mountain. They had followed Him for three years over dusty roads, up and down hills and through fields, so it was no big thing for them to follow Him then. They'd seen Jesus perform miracles, listened as He called powerful, ruthless men hypocrites, while He told these powerful men that prostitutes and tax collectors would enter heaven before they did. These were incredible things. But perhaps even more incredible were the things they had not seen Him do. They had never seen Him cower before or try to ingratiate Himself with the rich and powerful.

They had never seen Him use His powers to acquire wealth, position or fame. They had never seen Him hurt anyone.

He had made the blind see, but He had never made anyone blind. He had given life, but He had never killed. He had fed the multitudes, but He had never allowed anyone to go hungry in His presence. He had condemned the powerful, but He had never failed to forgive and raise up the weak, the poor, the shunned and disregarded. He had treated women with respect as human beings, and He had never abused or scorned them.
