16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops (Synod on Synodality)

Synod details

Venue & Purpose:-Vatican Oct. 4-29-to advise the Pope on the theme: “For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission.”

Participants:-A Total 364 delegates, including lay people will be full voting delegates-54 delegates are women. There are 75 other non voting participants who have been invited to act as facilitators or experts.

Breakdown:-The delegates are representatives who were selected by bishops’ conferences, Eastern Catholic Churches, leaders in the Roman Curia & 120 delegates selected by Pope Francis.

Goal:-In October 2024, participants will vote on a final document that will be presented to the pope. He can decide to adopt the text as a papal document or to write his own at the conclusion of the synod.

Archbishop Paul Etienne Archdiocese of Seattle writes on the Synod.

I’m too young to remember much about the Second Vatican Council. I am concerned so much of its vision (has) yet to be addressed by our Church. The Council knew that there would be a need to review and address changes. Their solution? Synods.

Pope Francis has chosen the topic of synodality for this synod. The word “synod” literally means to be together on a path. Synodality involves all the baptised, recognizing their unique gifts.

The synodal process began two years ago seeking the input of all the baptised. Synodality involves the communion of the entire people of God, who are co-responsible for the life and mission of the church.

“The synod now taking place is - and should be - a journey in accordance with the Spirit, not a parliament for demanding rights and claiming needs in accordance with the agenda of the world, nor an occasion for following wherever the wind is blowing, but the opportunity to be docile to the breath of the Holy Spirit.”
