Women in the Church

In my pastoral experience on different Church bodies, some of the sharpest advice came from women who were able to see from different angles, and who were above all practical, with a realistic understanding of how things work and people's limitations and potential. Before I was Pope, as archbishop in Buenos Aires I had women as financial director, chancellor, and head of the diocesan archive. It found that the advice of women in pastoral and administrative councils was more valuable than that of many men.

I want to make clear that an expanded role for women in Church leadership doesn't depend on the Vatican and is not limited to specific roles. Perhaps because of clericalism, which is a corruption of the priesthood, many people wrongly believe that Church leadership is exclusively male. But if you go to any diocese in the world you'll see women running departments, schools, hospitals, and many other organizations and programs; in some areas, you'll find many more women than men as leaders. In Amazonia, women - both laypeople and religious sisters - run whole Church communities. To say they aren't truly leaders because they aren't priests is clericalist and disrespectful.
