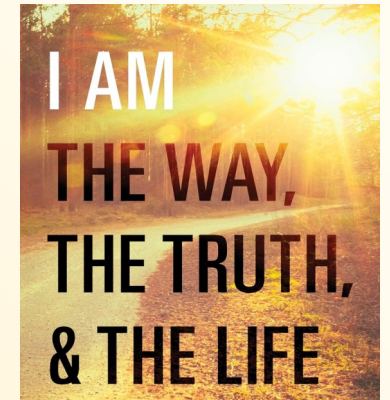

CULTURE NIGHT – Friday September 18th 2026

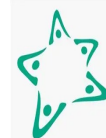
